This 9-credit online certificate program is for professionals who want to expand their knowledge and skills in the field of distance education and online learning. The program offers you the unique opportunity to learn from leaders in the field about distance and online teaching, design, research, and program development and assessment.

As an increasing number of academic institutions offer online programs, the demand for trained distance education professionals increases as well. Similarly, as business organizations look for more cost-effective ways of providing professional development opportunities for their employees, the need for trained distance education professionals will increase.

Curriculum

This certificate program consists of three required courses. All credits earned may be applied toward the Master of Education in Lifelong Learning and Adult Education if you apply and are granted admission into the program.

The course topics include introduction to adult education and distance education, distance education course design, and research and evaluation in distance education.
