Online Graduate Programs in Organization Development and Change

Penn State's online organization development and change (OD&C) programs are designed for professionals who need the skills and knowledge to effectively lead or initiate change in their organizations. The online format of these programs allows you to remain employed as you prepare for career advancement or transition into a management role.

The courses in the certificate programs integrate into the master's program, allowing you to work on both at the same time—or step up into the master's program, if you apply and are granted admission after earning your certificate. All programs are 100% online.

Online Graduate Certificates in Organization Development and Change

The OD&C portfolio of graduate certificates gives you the opportunity to earn an extra credential in a specialization. You can earn a stand-alone certificate, use it to step up into the master's program, or earn both at the same time. All certificates are 12 credits each.

OD&C Consulting Skills

Learn how to diagnose, implement, and evaluate organization development. The curriculum includes a foundation in OD as well as course work in marketing and consulting services.

OD&C Essentials


Build an essential knowledge base in OD&C. This certificate includes course work in process consultation, facilitating teams, and appreciative inquiry.

OD&C Operational Excellence

Focus on the concepts and skills you need to make effective contributions to projects, on time and within budget. The curriculum includes a foundation in OD as well as course work in project management, facilitating teams, and Lean Sigma.


