Master of Professional Studies in Ecosystem Management and Administration

As a student in the 30-credit online Master of Professional Studies (MPS) in Ecosystem Management and Administration, you will have the opportunity to develop improved skills to maintain efficient use of the world's natural resources. You can also expand your ability to apply quantitative tools, including statistics, financial analysis, and geographic information systems, to gain a broader understanding of the economic, financial, legal, and policy aspects of managing natural resources issues.

Specifically, throughout the program, you can gain:

- essential skills in working with spatial data and using geographic information management systems
- a better understanding of how ecosystems are inventoried and monitored and the ability to analyze common natural resource data sets to support decision-making

- project planning and management skills, including knowledge of decision support systems commonly used in natural resource planning and management
- improved communication, conflict resolution, negotiation, and leadership skills
- the ability to apply natural resource economics principles and cost-benefit analysis to common natural resource management problems
- a deeper understanding of the legal and policy framework in which ecosystem management decisions are made

By earning this advanced degree in ecosystem management, you may be prepared to become a more effective leader, decision maker, and manager at for-profit natural resource companies; local, state, and federal agencies; consulting firms; or select nongovernmental organizations.

Graduate Certificates in Ecosystem Management and Administration

You can start the master's program immediately, or you can opt to enhance your professional credentials along the way by earning one of these online ecosystem management and administration graduate certificates first. All of the required credits in these certificates can be applied toward the MPS in Ecosystem Management and Administration, if you apply and are accepted into the degree program.

Ecosystem Measurements and Data Analysis Graduate Certificate

This 9-credit certificate program can provide you with basic skills for managing ecosystem data collection programs and for using data to support decision-making. With course work in ecosystem monitoring, geographic information systems, and statistics, this three-course program is designed to improve your preparation for, and effectiveness in, higher-level management and leadership positions.

Leadership and Communication Skills for Ecosystem Managers Graduate Certificate

This 12-credit certificate program helps you develop your planning, leadership, communication, and conflict resolution skills. The four required courses cover topics that include ecosystem management, planning, and economics; environmental law and policy; leadership; and communication skills. You will have the opportunity to develop a deeper understanding of the legal, policy, and economic context in which you must work on a daily basis to accomplish your workplace goals.

Why Penn State?

Begin Your Application Today

Admissions decisions for the ecosystem management and administration programs are based on the quality of your credentials after a thorough review of your completed application portfolio.

For the MPS, your application portfolio must include:

- complete online application form and fee
- > transcripts from each postsecondary institution attended
- > GRE scores
- > TOEFL or IELTS scores, if applicable
- > references
- personal statement

For one of the graduate certificates, your application portfolio must include:

- complete online application form and fee
- transcripts from each postsecondary institution attended

As an applicant to one of Penn State's online ecosystem management and administration programs, you must have a bachelor's degree in an ecosystem management–related field, such as forestry, wildlife or fisheries management, soils or water management, natural resources management, environmental science, or ecology.
